Join our Extended Family... and make a real and lasting difference for children and young adults with a disability by helping them experience genuine friendship and community inclusion, including in sport, recreation and leisure.

Who

We are growing our 'family' of engaging and professional support workers who are excellent communicators and passionate about supporting others to access and participate in a range of community based interests.

We want motivated and reliable casual Inclusion Support Workers to work with participants with a disability aged between 4-30 years old and their families.

Ideally you will have past relevant experience and / or minimum Cert III qualification.

You will need a current satisfactory Police Check, a current employee Working with Children Check, a current Victorian Drivers Licence with access to an insured motor vehicle, and satisfactorily pass a Disability Worker Exclusion Scheme Check.

What

You could be taking someone to their weekly dance class, doing a regular leisure activity with them, helping them learn to use public transport, going to a café and helping them practice their social skills.

We have roles available to support participants in our:



LinC program (Linking+Inclusion+Community) which offers 'one on one' support to assist children and young people to access the community, skills training to enable participation and support to overcome barriers to access mainstream activities.

Where

Roles will be based in the following areas;

Northern Melbourne - Banyule, Nillumbik, Whittlesea, Darebin, and Yarra.

Inner & Outer East – Boroondara, Manningham, Monash, Whitehorse, Maroondah, Knox and Yarra Ranges

Roles in the East will be limited until the roll out of the NDIS commences in November 2017.

When

After school, weekends and school holidays are key times for these roles. Work may occur on a weekly, fortnightly or monthly basis and shift duration will usually range from 2-8 hours.

Our focus on community participation means you need to be prepared to work outside normal business hours.
